



LGBTQ+ respondents reported some of the highest levels of online hate and harassment of any groups surveyed




28% of LGBQ+* respondents reported severe harassment in the past 12 months, compared to 17% of non-LGBQ+

Sexually Harassed




of transgender respondents have ever been harassed online and 60% have been harassed severely


Share of Americans identifying as transgender who have experienced online harassment, by type
